

What is the Special Secretariat for COP30(Secop)


Created on March 19, 2024 (Decree 11,955), Secop is an agency linked to Office of the Chief Staff - Presidency of the Republic.

Created to coordinate the preparation of COP30 nationally.

It operates in an interministerial and interfederative manner, articulating actions with: Ministries, the government of the State of Pará, the city of Belém, civil society, the private sector and international organizations.

It serves as the focal point between the Federal Government and the United Nations.

The official portal can be accessed at COP30.br




Participants who are exempt from a visa to enter Brasil do not need to apply for it



COP30 Special E-visa



All accredited participants will be exempt from paying visa fees



Participants should begin the visa application process once their UNFCCC accreditation has been confirmed



IMPORTANT: There will be no issuance of visas upon arrival at airports in Brazilian territory

Safety and security

Brazil will implement an integrated security operation, carefully designed and planned to ensure a safe environment for all authorities and COP30 participants

This operation will cover not only the Blue Zone and the Green Zone, but also the entire **Metropolitan Region of Belém**, including tennis, residential condominiums and tourist areas

Health



All participants will have access to the public health structure (SUS)

Belém also has a wide private health network (Health Insurance)



An application will be made available with useful contacts and location of the back-up health services for the event



Offices and Pavilions

Expression of Interest open from June 18 and addressed exclusively to entities recognized by the UNFCCC.

Construction of the pavilions, in order to ensure operational control and efficiency in the assembly and disassembly phases.

Stakeholders will receive dedicated technical and logistical support at every stage of the planning and delivery process, until the end of the COP.

Three pavilion packages were structured using a modular approach, with features in line with previous editions of the Conference. Packaging varies according to the size and type of materials used


COP30 climate commitment



Accommodation Plan

The Brazilian government will guarantee the reservation of about 2,500 rooms at values of USD 100 to USD 600 to the 196 Parties, divided into two groups:

Group 1

73 countries Least Developed Countries (LDCs) and Small Island Developing States

15 rooms by delegation Values: between USD 100 to USD 220

Group 2

Other Parts

10 Rooms by delegation

Values: between USD 230 to USD 600
