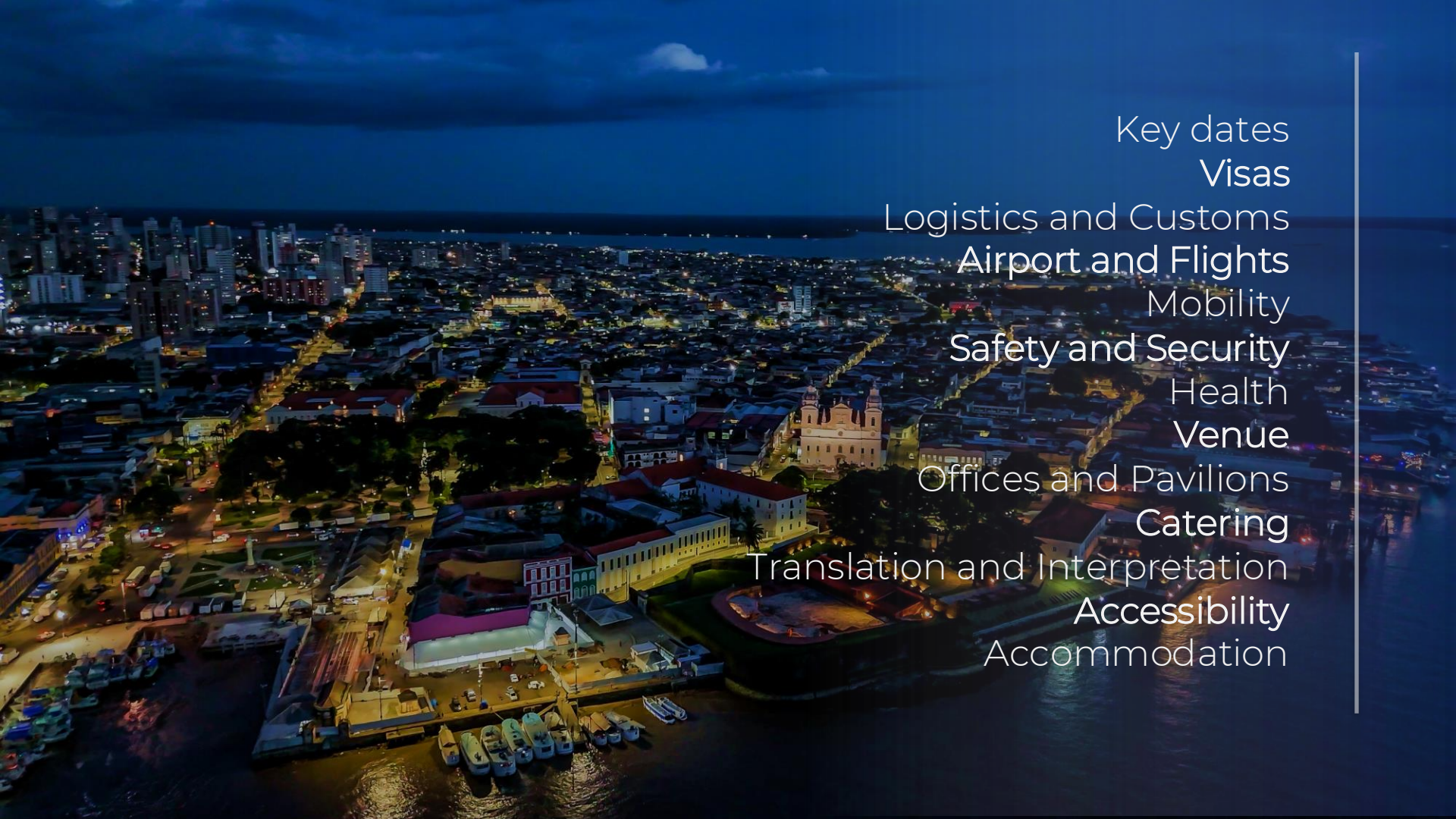

COP30 Special e-Visa



A special e-Visa for COP30 will be implemented, free of charge, based on UNFCCC accreditation



The official portal for application is available at cop30.br



Participants who are exempt from a visa to enter Brazil do not need to apply for one.



COP30 Special E-visa



All accredited participants will be exempt from paying visa fees



Participants should begin the visa application process as soon as their UNFCCC accreditation is confirmed



IMPORTANT: Visas will not be issued upon arrival at airports in Brazilian territory

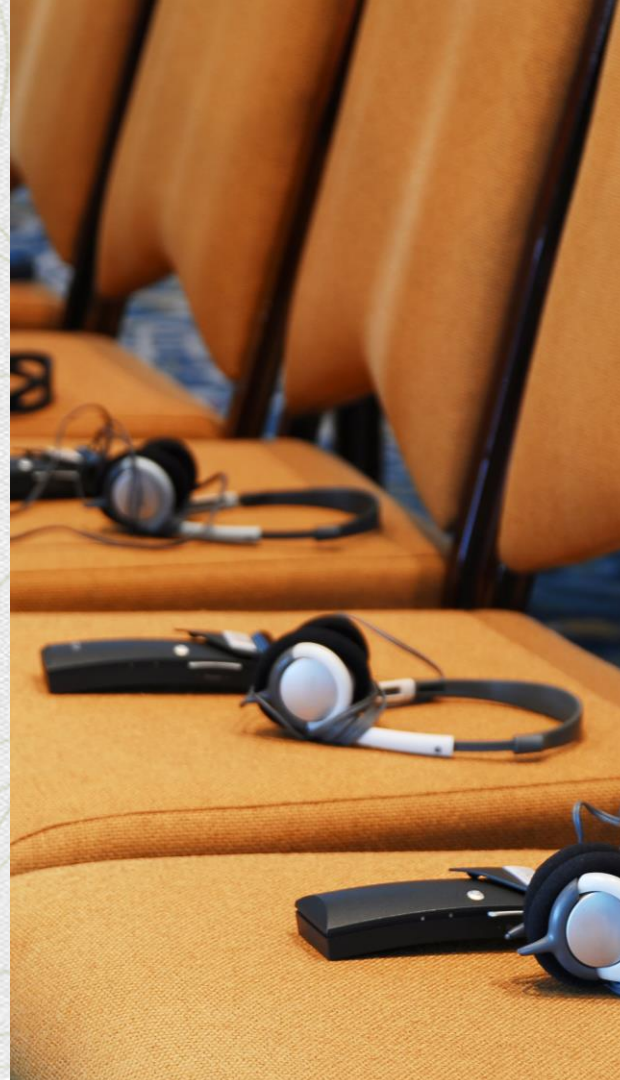

Voluntary Carbon Offsetting

COP30 will seek carbon neutrality certification (PAS 2060)

Participants will be able to offset their emissions through official voluntary offset mechanisms

COP30 Climate Commitment

It will be a carbon neutral event, following the international standard PAS 2060. All emissions generated will be carefully calculated, reduced where possible and transparently offset, reaffirming the commitment to global climate action.

Transparency and Participation in Compensation

The calculation methodology adopted will be that of the GHG Protocol, an internationally recognized standard.



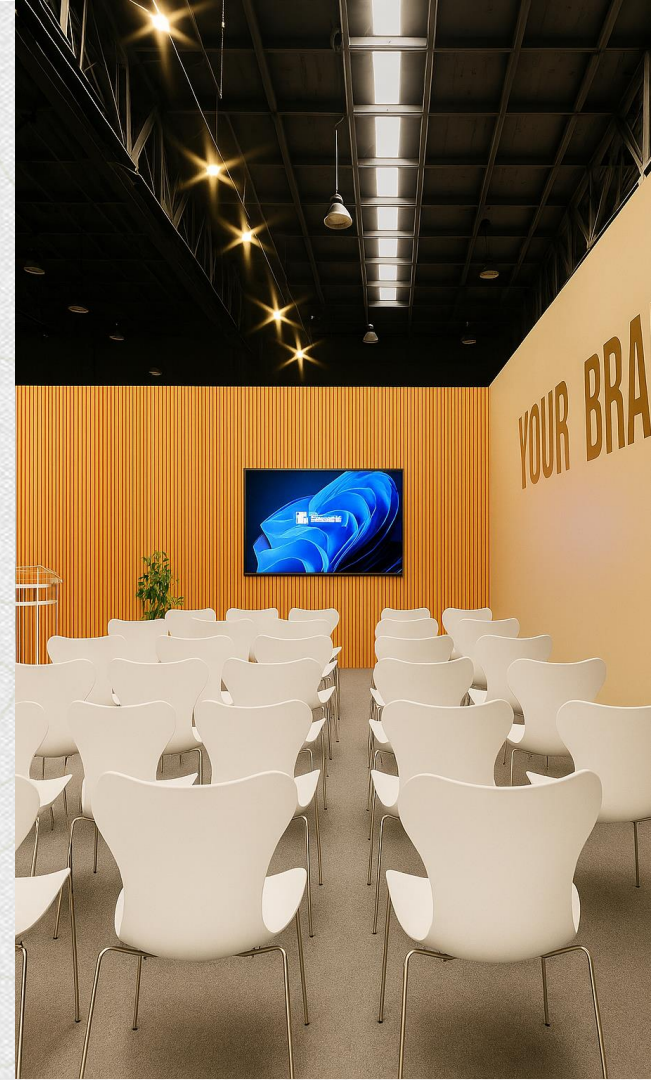
Offices and Pavilions

Expression of Interest (EOI) open from June 18th to July 2nd and exclusively directed at entities recognized by the UNFCCC.

An exclusive supplier was designated for the construction of the pavilions, in order to ensure operational control and efficiency in the assembly and disassembly phases.

Interested parties will receive dedicated technical and logistical support throughout all stages of the planning and delivery process, until the end of COP.

Three pavilion packages have been structured using a modular approach, with features aligned with previous editions of the Conference. The packages vary based on the size, type of materials used
